Understanding the New Federal Lighting Standards

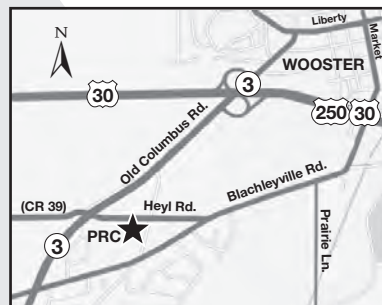
